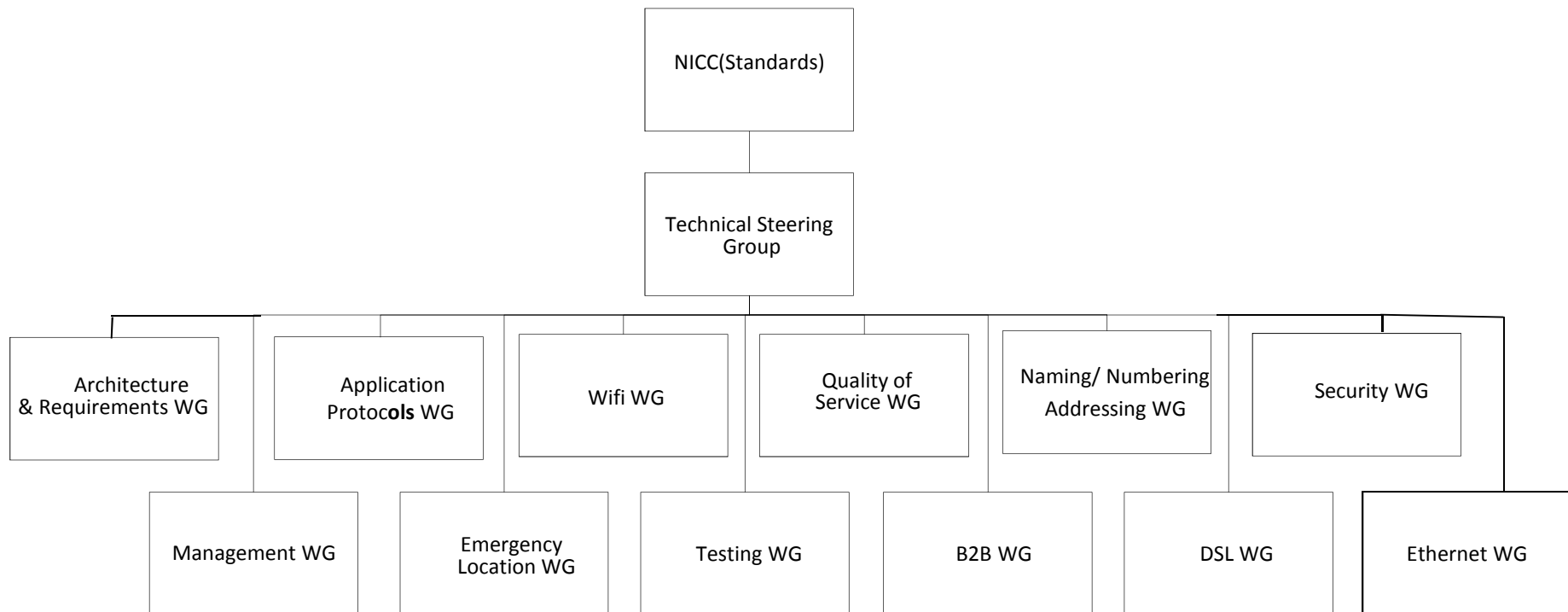

# Challenges faced by TSG

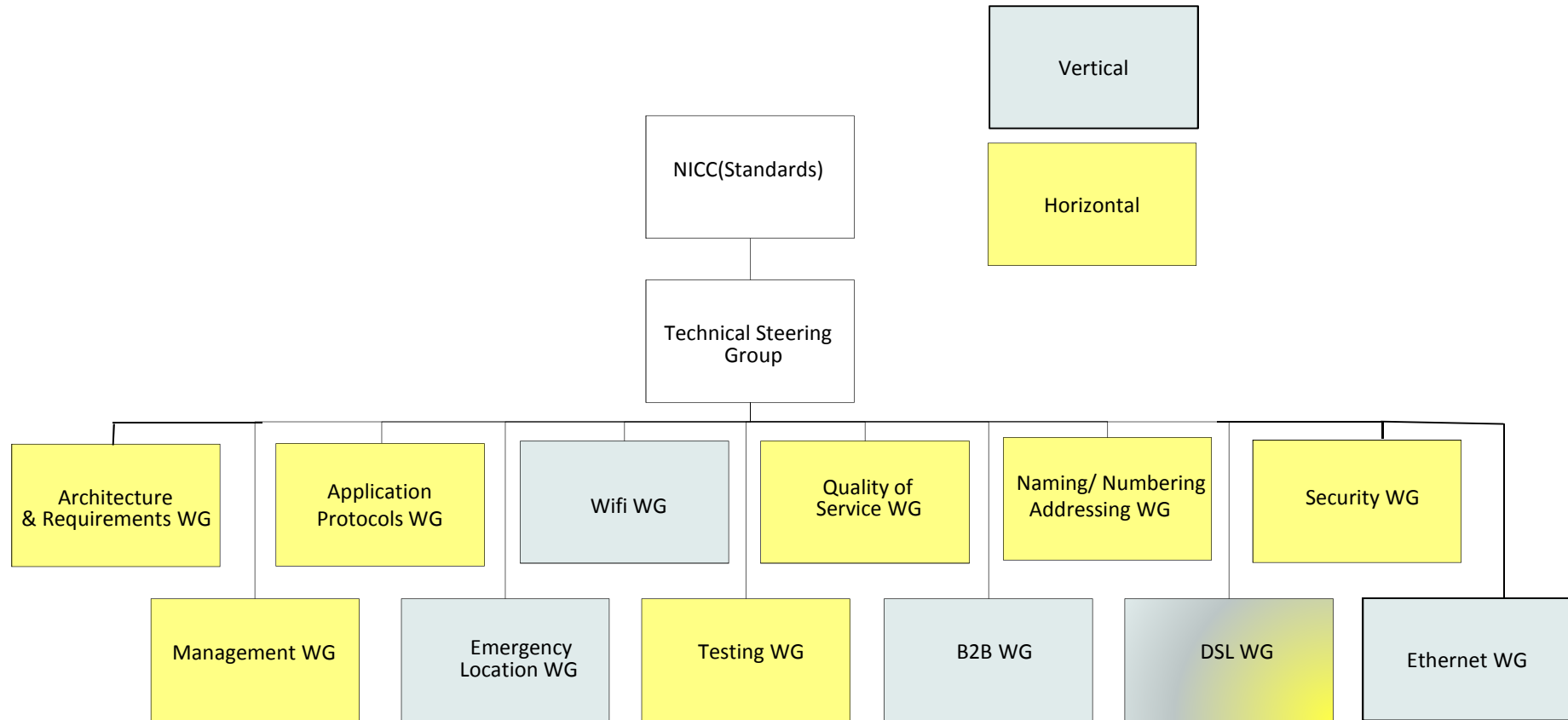
---

- Need to align our organisation with member resources

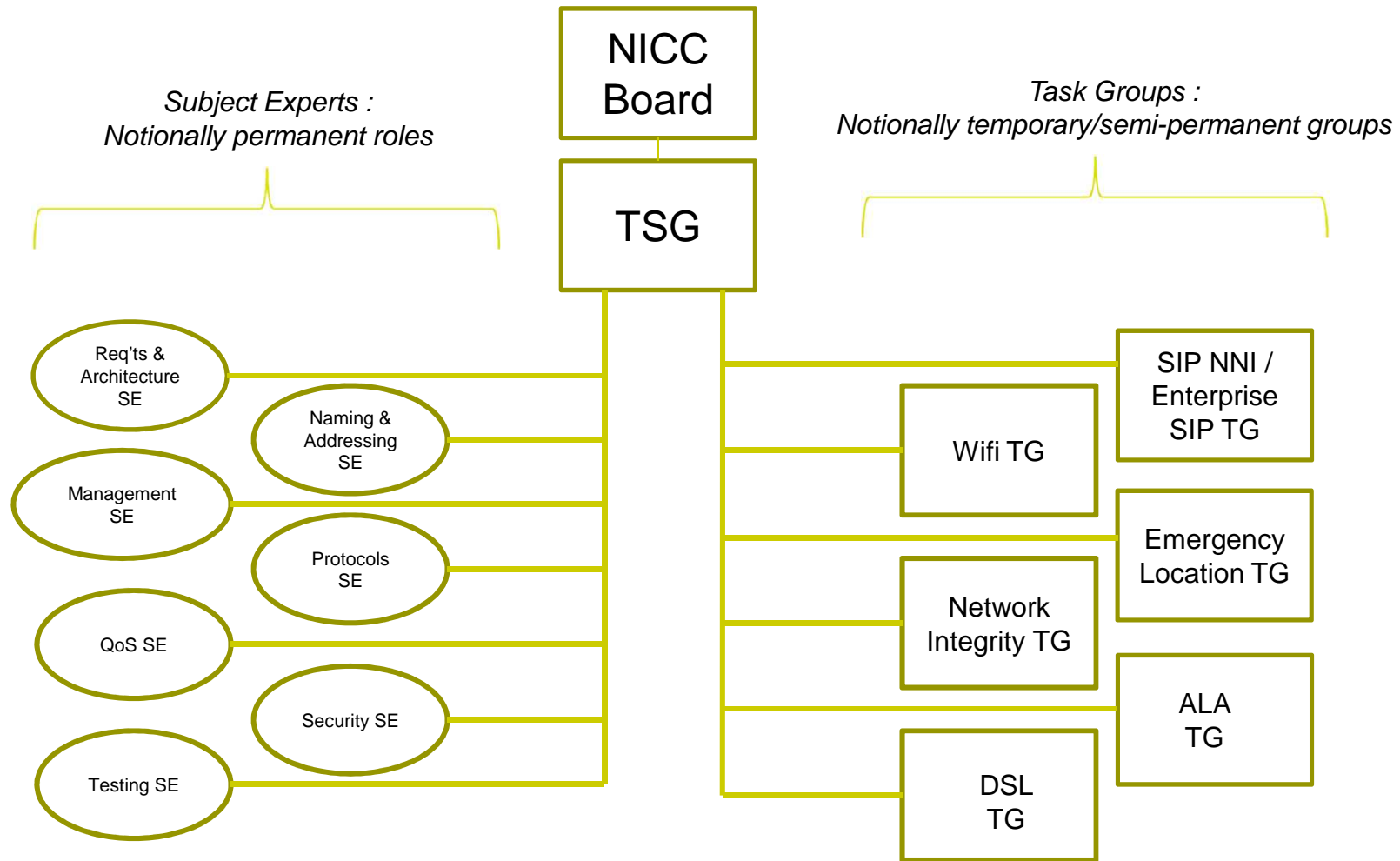
# Current TSG structure

- Are formed to address a specific work item / group of work items  
(although this doesn't preclude an already existing TG having their scope extended to address new activity)
- Address the topic from end-end
- Membership may evolve over time
- When activity completed, TG ordinarily dissolves

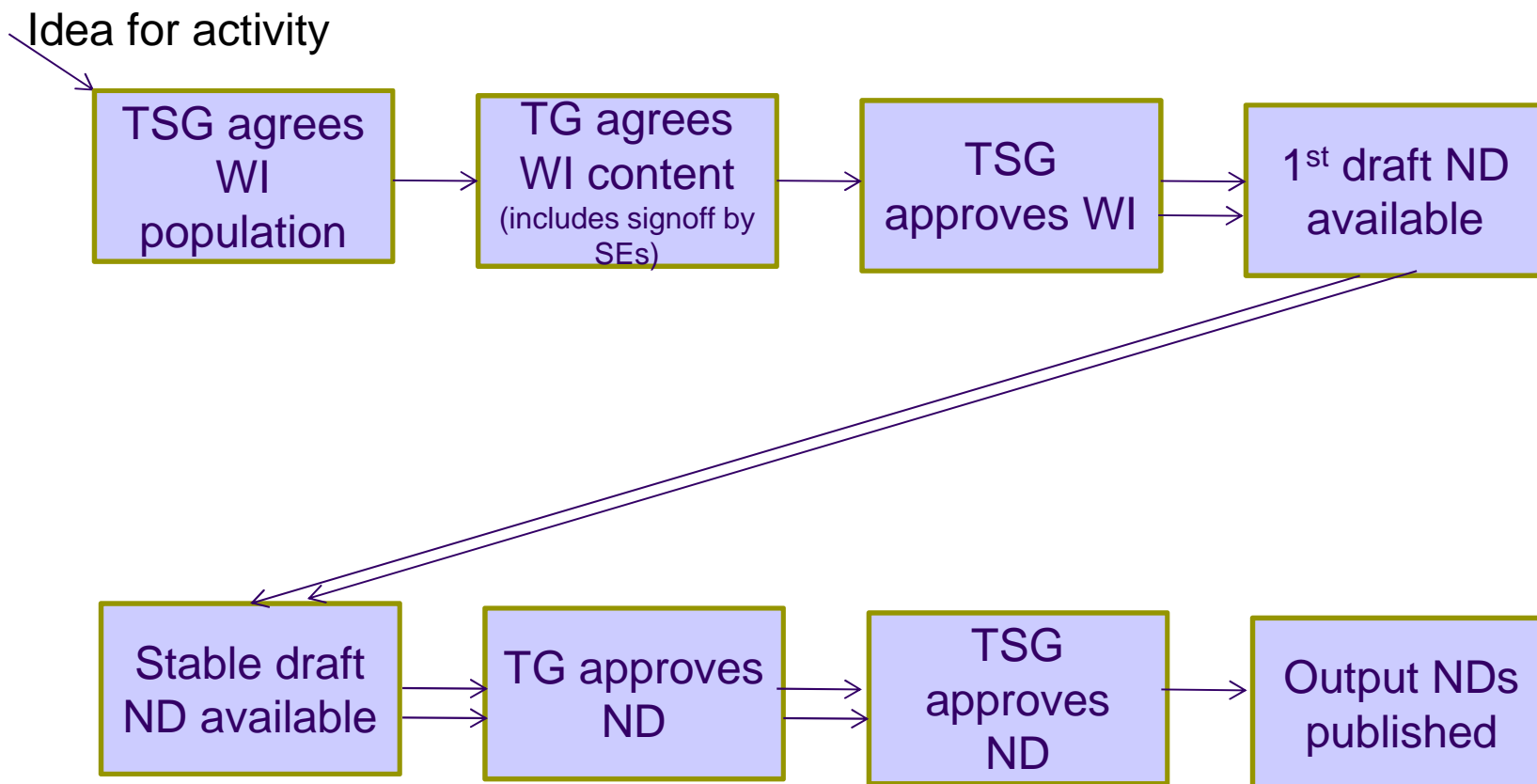
# Subject Experts

---

- Provide oversight of Task Groups
- Ensure their area of expertise is addressed by each TG in consistent manner
- Engages/mobilises member resources at appropriate time in TG's life cycle
- Nominally permanent function
