- ND1033 – NGA-Telephony SIP User profile
- ND1034 – UK SIPConnect Endorsement
- ND1035 – SIP Network to Network Interface Signalling (SIP-NNI)
- ND1037 – SIP NNI Interworking

ND1033

- Updated Calling Waiting and 3-Way Call descriptions
- Published in 09/2014

ND1034

- Endorsement of SIPConnect 1.1
- On-hold until ND1016 had been updated (N-CLI TG)
- Work has restarted in anticipation of the completion of ND1016
- May not be issued until the related interworking spec is completed.

ND1035

- New work items to include / update text on:
 - Signalling a Network Number CLI classified 'CLI Unavailable'
 - Emergency calls

ND1037

- Decision made to split the three key interworking areas into separate documents
- ND1037 will specify interworking of ND1035 to/from ND1007 (ISUP)/ND1026 (BICC)
- Interworking of ND1033 to/from ND1035 and ND1034 to/from ND1035 will be tackled later and will given their own ND number

ND1037 (cont'd)

- Key areas of interest
 - CLI interworking
 - LDLI / Redirecting Number mapping
 - Mapping of priority indications for emergency calls
 - An end-to-end service description for the handling of emergency calls would help.
